## Town of Big Bend

N1195 Hwy 40 New Auburn, WI 54724 @ Town Hall Open Saturdays (4/1 to 10/31) 8 am to Noon other from November through March 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> same hours Cost of garbage \$2 for 13 gallon, \$4 for 14-32 gallon and \$6 for 32 or larger.

## Town of Willard

W7480 Broken Arrow Rd, Conrath, WI 54731 Open 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Saturdays from 8 am to 2 pm Cost of garbage is \$3.00 per bag no matter the size.

#### Town of Thornapple

N4925 Thornapple Rd Ladysmith, WI 54848 Open Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm Cost of garbage ranges from \$1.50 to \$7.50 depending on size

For those that contract with a waste hauler, it is still law to recycle. Not all contractors have curbside recycling service so you may still need to bring your recycling to a drop off site.
