Caucus adjourned at 6:49PM.


- 1.) Monthly board meeting was called to order by Chairperson, Betsy Patterson, at 6:50PM. All members were in attendance, with Richard Brand by phone. Audience members: Randy and Tanya Bronstad. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 2.) Richard Brand made a motion to dispense with the reading of minutes from the Monday, December 5, 2016 regular monthly board meeting and approve. Steve Henderson seconded motion. All approved and motion carried.
- 3.) Public comment, none.
- 4.) Treasurer's report given by Peggy Linskey. Discussion of need to borrow money from savings until later in month to pay all the bills.
- 5.) Clerk's report. Clerk shared information received in the mail. Clerk discussed needing approval for sending possibly 2 poll workers to chief election officer training. Betsy Patterson made motion to approve and was seconded by Steve Henderson. All approved and motion carried. Shared information regarding new electronic system for building inspectors, Betsy will contact ours to share.
- 6.) Presentation by Randy and Tanya Bronstad, new owner's of River's Edge Resort, for application for a Conditional Use Permit. They are asking to have campers in their mobile trailer area. Shared information with board members, discussion and questions by board members. Steve Henderson made motion to approve and sign conditional use permit application. Seconded by Betsy Patterson. All approved and motion carried for approval of application. Board members signed and passed along to zoning. Bronstads' reminded board they would be opening bar on April 1, 2017.
- 7.) Chairman's report. Betsy shared information. She shared she had observed complaints from residents on Facebook regarding plowing, especially after last ice/snow storm, but town was out of sand and waiting for deliveries. Discussion that Betsy, Peg, and Deb will probably go to the District meeting on March 25 to

- represent the town and gather information. Heater in shop is installed and working. Town now has a website set up and agenda will be printed on it. Discussion regarding calls/texts from assessor who reports that the previous assessor did not do his necessary paperwork. Some of his records/assessments have not been touched since 1999, also missing many, many hard copies. She reports she may not be finished until late summer to schedule BOR. Board members discussed what to do... will see what direction present assessor points them in, possible criminal prosecution. \*\*Richard Brand signed off.\*\*
- 8.) Motion made by Betsy Patterson to review invoices and pay bills. Seconded by Steve Henderson. All approved and motion passed.
- 9.) Motion made by Betsy Patterson to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Steve Henderson. All approved and motion carried.
